

## Brandon Hills, the far East trails.

When I got up this morning and saw where the weather was headed I thought I should make a trip to Brandon Hills before the cold snap got us in its grip. I had planned to go out and deploy 2 additional geocaches on the east side of the trail system.

My plan was to make my approach from the extreme South East corner. Unfortunately the access road North off Highway 453 was not drivable. This added an additional 3.5 km to my hike.

My destination was the old blue car. The trails I took to the car were Easy Up, Lucky 3, and Lucky 2 Trails. I made a stop on Lucky 3 to hide the first geocache.



At the car I had a break with a snack of tea with a morning glory muffin and cheese.



The return Journey took me on Paul's Trail, North and South, Ron's Hill and Gun Club Trails, with a stop on Paul's Trail to hide the second cache. The trails were quite difficult to follow on the return trip, so I had to navigate with my GPSr.

I had taken my snowshoes anticipating that I would need them, but the walking was easier without them. 9.7 km for the total trip.
