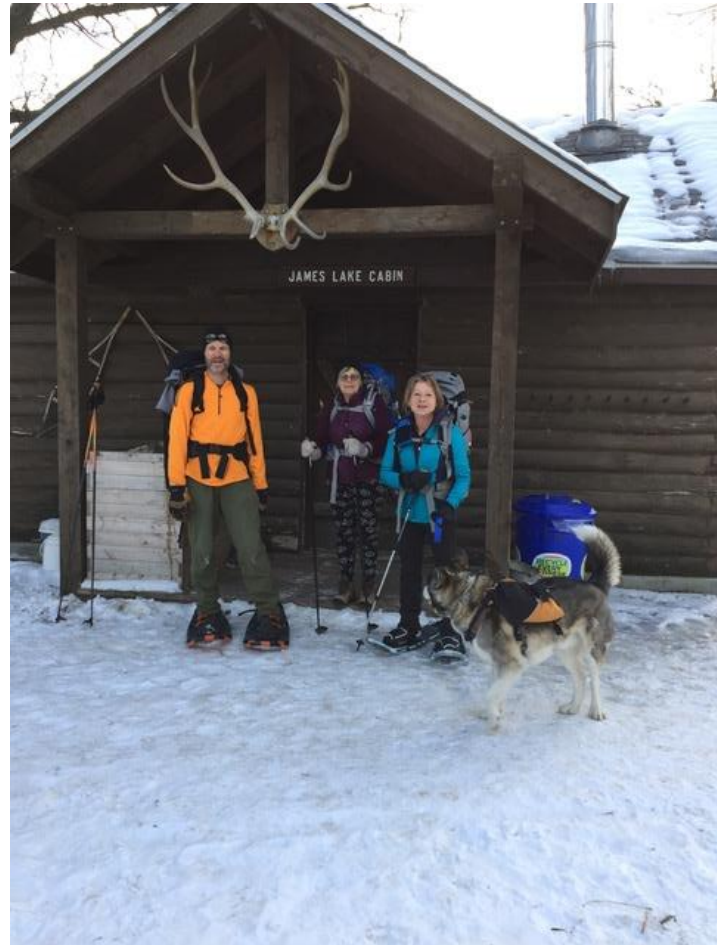


James Lake Trip Review from Dec. 12-13, 2021
